A SOAP COMPANY REVOLUTIONIZES SHELL LOADING

P & G's Involvement in WWII & the Korean War

By Homer Buescher, ChE, US Navy, WWII, P&G retiree & RESC member will reveal to the public for the first time, this P&G story.



Our own Homer Buescher, US Navy, WWII, speaks on how Procter & Gamble got involved in the shell loading business in 1940. This should be of great interest to those that lived through WWII and WWII history buffs. Homer will describe how the U.S. secretly agreed to produce ammunition for Great Britain before Pearl Harbor. The information is no longer secret, but because it involved the British government before the U.S. entered the war, it was top secret then. Homer will reveal the major changes pioneered by Procter and Gamble that revolutionized the industry and tremendously increased production and safety. To his knowledge, this is the first time this information has been put together and released to the public.

Homer was born in Saint Louis and served in the U.S. Navy in WWII, becoming a pilot, then a deck officer on destroyer escorts, and trained in submarines. He majored in Chemical and Industrial Engineering, in college. After graduation, he joined P&G in Baltimore, MD. He was transferred to the Army shell loading plant in Milan, TN when the Korean War broke out. He retired as the Company's Human Factors Engineering Consultant.

MATHCOUNTS SEEKING VOLUNTEERS TO GRADE EXAMS ON FEBRUARY 28

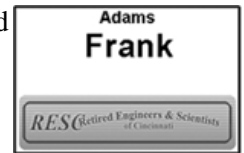
