## Meeting Highlights

Costa Rica- the Central American Surprise  
by Carl and Marjorie Evert

The presentation is a composite of two Elderhostel trips to Costa Rica about ten years apart and will cover the significant features of this “country without an army” from an historical and environmental perspective with pictures of the lush tropical flora, rain forests, rivers, birds and animals, as well as a discussion on the surprising complexities of growing bananas.

Carl Evert is a University of Cincinnati Emeritus Professor of Electrical and Computer Engineering where he taught a wide range of topics and served as the first Director of the University Computer Center and established the early laboratories for computer engineering, modeling and simulation studies. During his twenty-eight years at UC, he consulted with many local industries and Children’s Hospital. Sponsorship from the National Science Foundation and UNESCO resulted in assignments to the University of Madras, India and the Bucharest Polytechnic Institute, Romania and a research hospital in Australia.

During a sabbatical leave from UC, he earned a Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering at the University of Wisconsin and after leaving UC he created a Computer Science program and computing center during a two year stint at Thomas More College and a program in Computer Information Systems in the Business School at Xavier University where he taught an additional five years.

Post retirement assignments with the International Executive Service Corps were in the Dominican Republic and Kenya. Carl has served in the sequence of positions leading to the President of the RESC and in other civic and professional organizations

Marjorie Evert was chemistry student at the College of Wooster and completed her studies at the University of Cincinnati. After her children were out of high school, she returned to UC and earned a Master of Business Administration and

taught Corporate Finance at Xavier University as an Adjunct Associate Professor in the School of Business Administration for fifteen years.
