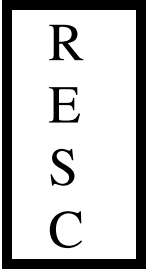

He can discuss local, state and national politics, including presidential campaigns and how the media covers politics and the media in general. He can talk on how technology is changing politics and how he believes we will eventually see the emergence of not just a third party, but a fourth and even fifth party in American and local politics.

Pat's also a freelance writer and has appeared in *Newsweek*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *American Bar Association Journal*, *Family Circle* and *Beer magazines*. (Note: His family has operated Crowley's Highland House Café for 70 years.)

He is also the co-author of *Saving Grace*, a true crime book published this year, and is working on two more books; one about a soldier's experience in Iraq and the other about a sensational murder-for-hire crime in Northern Ky. He also hosts four TV programs a week on ICN 6 cable in Northern KY.

He lives in Fort Thomas with his wife and children and is a graduate of Ohio State University.
